Our lives are filled with the same sort of everyday tasks like doing the laundry, emptying the dishwasher, cleaning the house, completing homework. Try choosing one everyday task and do it slowly, mindfully and sacrificially as a prayer.

- **Create:** Use your creativity and markers/crayons/paint to create [“I’m thinking of you”](#) cards to give to your neighbors or drop them off at church and we’ll send to LGPC shut-ins.
- **Listen:** As you [LISTEN HERE](#) to the story of the Good Samaritan think about these questions:
 1. I wonder if the person left by the side of road has a name.
 2. I wonder who was a neighbor to the robber, the priest, the Levite, the Samaritan? Who are our neighbors?
