NOVEMBER PLAYLIST

OVERVIEW

This month our focus in LGK is discovering how the Bible, God's written word, came into existence and how the whole book is one continuous, redemptive, rescue story. Not only will we discuss the anatomy of the Bible's structure, we will also look at how the person of Jesus Christ is woven through both the old and new testaments. The Bible is a story of God's faithfulness and his love; a story that is still being written today with all of us as characters in the unfolding narrative.

PRAYER FOCUS

A scripture prayer uses God's word to help you pray. One way is to read the scripture as a prayer. For example, you could pray Psalm 46:1 like this, "God, thank you for being my place of safety. Thank you for giving me strength to get through each day. Thank you for being there when I am in trouble and need help. Amen." Another way to pray using scripture is to pick a short passage (3-5 verses) in the Bible (Psalms is a great book to do this from) and read it through a few times. What words stand out to you? Create a prayer using those words.
