The volunteer will receive the food list by Friday, July 30, and the groceries will be picked up from the volunteer's home on Tuesday morning, August 3rd. Volunteers can get reimbursed from Family Promise for the groceries they purchase or they can take a tax deduction for their donation (a tax deduction form will also be provided.)
